

Motus' Darwin Evolves The Wiimote

Expected in time for the holidays, the Darwin controller from Motus looks like it will take motion-sensing gaming up a considerable notch. Resembling a Hattori Hanzo sword handle, the Darwin uses gyroscopes, accelerometers, and a compass to track motion rather than infrared signals, meaning no need for a sensor bar, Wii fans. The Darwin is reportedly based on Motus' existing iClub golf controller and will work with PCs and multiple consoles. Additionally, Motus claims Darwin is faster and more accurate than the Wiimote.
